Chesapeake Bay Program (CBP) Blueprint:

- Development of new indicator and decision-making framework for CBP
 - Previous CBP agreement, the Chesapeake 2000 agreement, has mostly expired (except for some ongoing commitments)
 - Current CBP groups (Alignment Action Team, Indicators Work Group, and ChesapeakeStat) are working towards new indicator development and a logic framework for adaptive management
 - o Beginning as a bottom up approach:
 - GITs will develop goals vetted through their membership, Management Board (MB) approval, Principals Staff Committee and Executive Council agreement
- We see this as an opportunity to get involved early in the discussions while we have the ability to shape the new CBP structure
- Latest CBP MB meeting consisted of discussions on individual GIT's goals and cross-cutting GIT topics
 - Clear that Healthy Watershed, Habitat, and Fisheries GIT have several important cross-cutting ideas
