TC Land Total Acres: Total Acres within each boundary minus water

TC Existing Acres: Current tree cover

TC Possible Acres: Sum of Possible Vegetation and Possible Impervious

<u>TC Possible Impervious</u>: Asphalt and concrete surfaces, excluding roads and buildings, that are theoretically available for establishment of tree canopy, AKA: you need a jack hammer to plant a tree <u>TC Possible Vegetated</u>: Grass or shrub area that is theoretically available for the establishment of tree canopy, FYI: includes baseball fields, ect.

TC Land Total = TC Existing **plus** TC Possible **plus** Roads/Buildings
