- Discussion with Greg Garman on team's next steps:
  - Kill-on-capture will be difficult to implement/enforce and will not significantly reduce populations
  - o Full eradication is not physically or monetarily feasible
- The team could scope out potential "control" approaches:
  - o 1.) Public awareness campaign to educate and inform public
  - o 2.) "Control" and "Surveillance" Pilot Project: (should include)
    - a. Develop a control pilot project for select (MD and VA) tribs
    - b. Create baseline GIS model of all potential blue catfish habitats across the bay
    - c. Design a targeted monitoring/surveillance and rapid response system to control spread
