## **ASMFC Meeting Pre-Brief Topics**

#### Menhaden

- Toni Kerns summarized the Technical Committees (TC) work on reference points.
  - Document states we are not overfished, but overfishing is occurring for the first time in the last nine years. The TC is going to go over alternative reference points.

## **River Herring/Shad**

- The river herring terms of reference (TOR) agenda item is to approve the TORs for the river herring assessment scheduled to be completed at the end of the year
  - o Peer review early 2012
- Chris Zeman from the Mid-Atlantic Fishery Management Council will ask the Management Board to support a federal FMP for shad and river herring
- Two additional terms of reference (TOR) being requested
- TC will conduct a coast wide stock assessment
  - o Currently 28-30 river systems, but not combined into one assessment

## **Striped Bass**

- Tom O'Connell will provide an update on MD poaching incidences
- Stock assessment will be completed in November at Massachusetts

### **Blue Catfish**

- ASMFC statement on Blue Catfish
  - Issue put on policy board agenda
  - Concern over potential impacts of ASMFC managed species
  - o Policy board is developing a resolution

## **Oyster Metric Team Update**

- Team has developed both 'Reef-Level' and 'Tributary-Level' goals
- Currently in drafting phase and hope to submit to consulting scientists by first week in April
- Goals:
  - o Reef-Level: (6 years post restoration)
    - a. Are structures still present? Are oysters surviving?
    - b. Reef footprint and height must be sustained or growing
    - c. Neutral or positive shell budget

- d. Biological:
  - i. Maintain minimum density
  - ii. Maintain target density
  - iii. At least 2 year classes present
- o Tributary-Level:
  - a. Will count as restored when 'x' percentage of "currently restorable bottom" is restored

# **Catfish Workgroup Proposal**

- Executive Committee still concerned that this group is reluctant to think outside the box
- Action Items:
  - o Consider new/expanded membership
    - a. Resource Economist with fisheries experience
    - b. Invasive, Non-Native Species Expert
