

Virginia Fishery-Independent Trawl Surveys

- Juvenile Fish & Blue Crab Trawl Survey
- ChesMMAP Trawl Survey
- NEAMAP Trawl Survey










Juvenile Fish and Blue Crab Trawl Survey

- Sampling since 1955, year-round
- Operates in the Virginia mainstem bay & tributaries
- Targets juvenile fishes






ChesMMAP Trawl Survey

(Ches. Bay Multispecies Monitoring & Assessment Program)

- Sampling since 2002, March through November
- Operates in the mainstem of Chesapeake Bay
- Targets late juvenile & adult fishes






NEAMAP Trawl Survey

(Northeast Area Monitoring and Assessment Program)

- Sampling since 2007,
 Spring & Fall
- Coastal waters from MA to NC (inshore compliment of NEFSC BTS)
- Targets late juvenile & adult fishes

Biological

- Distribution
- Abundance

- Diet (Trophic Int.)

Hydrographic

- Water Temp.
- Salinity
- DO Concentration
- DO Saturation
- Light Availability

Atmospheric

- Air Temp.
- Wind Speed
- Wind Direction
- Baro. Pressure
- Cloud Cover

Long time series with consistent sampling protocols facilitate investigations of environmental change and species response




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

Summer Flounder Management Options...

- 1) For a given annual quota, maintain <u>some</u> <u>percentage</u> at <u>historical</u> allocation, with the <u>remainder</u> to be allocated based on the <u>"new" distribution</u>
- 2) For a given annual quota, maintain <u>historical</u> allocation <u>to the rebuilt level</u>, with any <u>surplus</u> allocated based on the <u>"new" distribution</u>
