

Oyster Projects

- Rotational Plantings of wild diploid seed on mid river oyster bars
- Triploid plantings of the “Lola” strain on Ragged Pt. Bar
 - Intended to be economically self sustaining through fees and taxes associated with the program
 - Participation in the program has grown
 - 15 in 2012
 - 23 in 2013
 - 35 in 2014
 - Planting areas have grown
 - 4 acres in 2012
 - 5 acres in 2013
 - 10 acres in 2014
 - September 2014 is the first harvest
- Sanctuary assessments

Blue Crab

- Harvest report modifications to include observations of blue crab mortality

Finfish

- Kitt’s Point Artificial Reef Project nearing completion off the mouth of the St. Mary’s River
- Efforts to connect Blue catfish harvesters to wholesalers
