

Chesapeake Bay Program's Modeling Meetings Update

April 9, 2012 CBP Water Quality Goal Implementation Team Conference Call

The following key meetings have or will be discussing options for the next generation of Chesapeake Bay Program models:

- STAC Gunston Cove Multiple Models Workshop – April or May – Workshop to discuss pilot project on using multiple hydrodynamic, water quality, and ecosystem models in shallow estuarine environment.
- Proposed STAC Workshop on Multiple Models for Management – Mid-Late 2012. Workshop would discuss scientific questions on the benefits of multiple models and the opportunities and challenges in applying multiple models to management
- Modeling Quarterly Review – April 16-17 Annapolis Chesapeake Bay Program Office
- Chesapeake Community Modeling Program Symposium May 21-22 – Double Tree Hotel Annapolis. Theme: Interfacing between modeling, management and the public: TMDLs, politics, litigation and conflicting stakeholder interests
- Laboratory Recommendation Action Team - Multiagency, multi-partner group is being formed as directed by the PSC and Management Board to respond to the NAS modeling laboratory recommendation. The first meeting date has yet TBD.
- Open to option of full day WQGIT meeting in the Fall on model updates
- Various panels will have recommendations that influence the next generation of models
 - Nutrient Management
 - Stream Restoration
 - Urban Fertilizer Panel
 - STAC P-simulation
