Jeff Sweeney, EPA, returns to the AgWG seeking a decision following a [February review](#) of findings from investigations on alternatives to the current methods for forecasting agricultural land uses and animals. In February, two options were proposed to the AgWG for partnership consideration. The AgWG was asked to review the Ag Census Projection Analysis [spreadsheet](#) and provide any feedback to Sucharith Ravi, UMCES, and Jeff by March 8<sup>th</sup>.

- Option #1: Keep current projection method (Dbl. Exp. Smoothing: Alpha = 0.8) **RECOMMENDED**
- Option #2: Change to Linear Projection (Method 2)
