**12:45 PM Combined Revised Proposal for Ensuring Full Access to Federal Cost Shared Conservation Practices and Addressing Double Counting – Dean Hively/Olivia Devereux**

**ACTIONS REQUESTED:** Committee members direct feedback to Dean and Olivia on: 1) whether the process(es) being proposed will truly ensure full access to federal cost shared conservation practices; 2) whether the procedures recommended will address concerns for double counting; and 3) discussion on exactly what we are going to ask the PSC to decide.

**1:45 PM Institutionalizing the Application of Life Spans into our Tracking, Verification, and Reporting Systems – Mark Dubin/Tom Schueler**

**ACTIONS REQUESTED:** Committee members direct feedback to Mark and Tom on: 1) whether the proposed approaches to application of life span will be acceptable to the jurisdictions and federal agency partners (e.g., USDA); 2) are there alternative ways to getting to the same outcome; 3) whether the Committee is comfortable with the proposed next steps; and 4) discussion of exactly what we are going to ask the PSC to decide in terms of enforcing life spans within our tracking, verification and reporting systems.

**2:30 PM Review of the Forthcoming Decision Making Process and Final Schedule – Rich Batiuk**

**DECISIONS REQUESTED:** The Committee's decision on whether the full suite of the basinwide BMP verification framework components—BMP principles, BMP verification protocols, BMP verification review panel, procedures for ensuring full accounting of federal cost shared practices/addressing double counting, and procedures for clean-up of historical BMP databases—to determine if they are ready for review and approval by the rest of the partnership or the Committee needs to request the Management Board for a one more final schedule extension. If a time extension is requested, the Committee reaches agreement on the final schedule leading to PSC adoption of the basinwide BMP verification framework and all its components (Attachment A).

**DECISION REQUESTED:** The Committee's revised, refinement and agreement on the proposed decision making process for the partnership's adoption and implementation of the basinwide verification program (Attachment A).
