Federal Agency Evaluation Check-In- Greg Allen, EPA Overview and description of opportunities for comments and feedback on the draft Federal Agency Evaluation.	10:05-10:35	Greg Allen talked about Two-year Milestone Evaluations: Strengths and Missed Milestones. Most federal programmatic milestones are either complete or showing substantial progress. The EPA EVALUATION OF FEDERAL AGENCY 2020-2021 and 2022-2023 MILESTONES document and the RESTORE CLEAN WATER ACTIONS: Federal Water Quality Two-Year Milestones for 2020-2021 document have been released. Comments from federal agencies are due on the 18 th of July. You can view the documents here . Proposed Action Item: Agency reviews July 8-18. Greg highlighted The Federal BMP Record Completeness and Credit Evaluations for 2020-2021 and then moved into talking about Jurisdiction Federal coordination meetings. 2022 BMP Data Request - Greg Allen, EPA Within the next couple weeks, the Bay Program will be sending out the annual data call letter to agencies requesting their 2022 BMP progress data.	10:35-11:00	Greg reminded folks that the annual BMP request letter will be coming out shortly with more direction about the annual Best Management Practices (BMP) data submittal (for BMPs installed July 1, 2021-June 30, 2022). The due date for submission of reports to the jurisdictions is October 1, 2022. Note: Agencies that recently submitted a historic BMP record and have no additional BMPs to report, will only have to notify the jurisdiction that the previous submission was complete.
