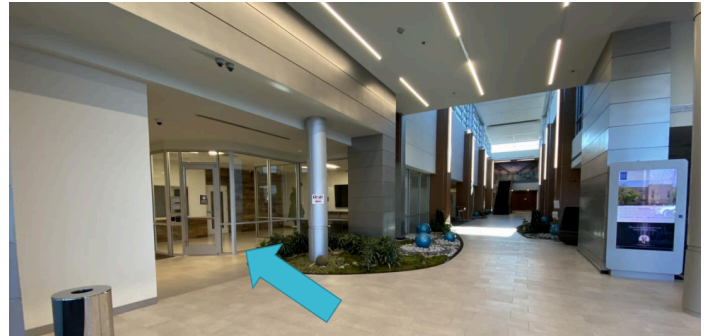


Parking

- 1750 Forest Drive has a free, open parking lot. Parking is available at the front, back, and sides of the building. **Visitors should park in the front parking lot (Photo 1) and enter through the main lobby.** The front doors to the building will be unlocked.

Food will/will not be provided. There is a fridge/kitchenette where you can place your lunch if you plan to bring it from home. There is free hot water, coffee and tea. Bathrooms:

Restrooms are located outside of the CBPO meeting and office space. Remember to grab a guest pass so you can get back into the conference room. To access the bathroom, press “2” and “4” at the same time, then “3”, then “Enter”. Bathrooms are wheelchair accessible and labeled Men and Women.

Accessibility:

The building is wheelchair accessible but the door to the office does not have an automatic open/close button. The building is not fragrance free. There is a lactation room in the office. There are semi-private huddle rooms. Conference rooms are brightly lit. During the meeting there will be open captions available.
