Leverage **networks** across workgroups for **nature-based solutions** expertise to promote benefits across landscapes.

# How the HLGT can support the LUDS outcome

- Promote land use data and related CBP products when engaging with communities on restoration projects, adaptation work, etc.
- Strengthen our ability to communicate locally relevant and actionable information.
- Leverage partnership networks to improve engagement with local governments and trusted sources.
- Encourage consistent documentation and sharing of land use and CBP data use cases.
- Foster cross-workgroup awareness and advocacy for shared tools, data, and resources.
