2 min (0.8 mi)

- Head west on Fountain St toward S Union Ave
- Turn right at the 1st cross street onto S Union Ave
- S Union Ave turns left and becomes Otsego St

Follow MD-155 W and MD-161 N to Old Quaker Rd in Darlington

18 min (12.2 mi)

- Turn right onto N Juniata St
- Turn left onto Superior St
- Continue straight onto MD-155 W/Superior St
- Turn right onto MD-161 N

Take Shuresville Rd to Shures Landing Rd

6 min (2.6 mi)

- Turn right onto Old Quaker Rd

–Turn right onto Shuresville Rd

–Slight left to stay on Shuresville Rd

–Turn right

–Turn left onto Shures Landing Rd

Arrive at Conowingo Fisherman's Park
