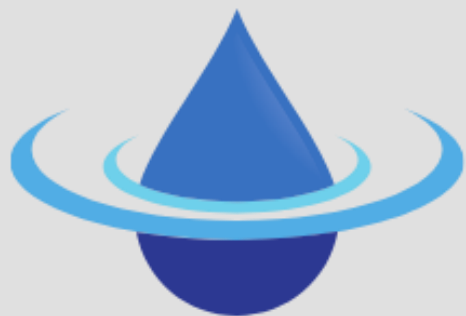

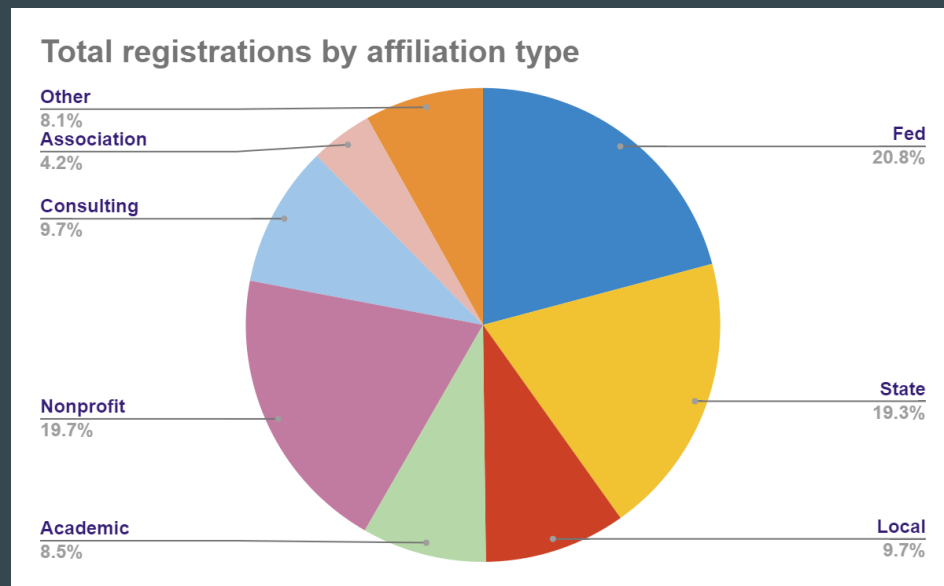

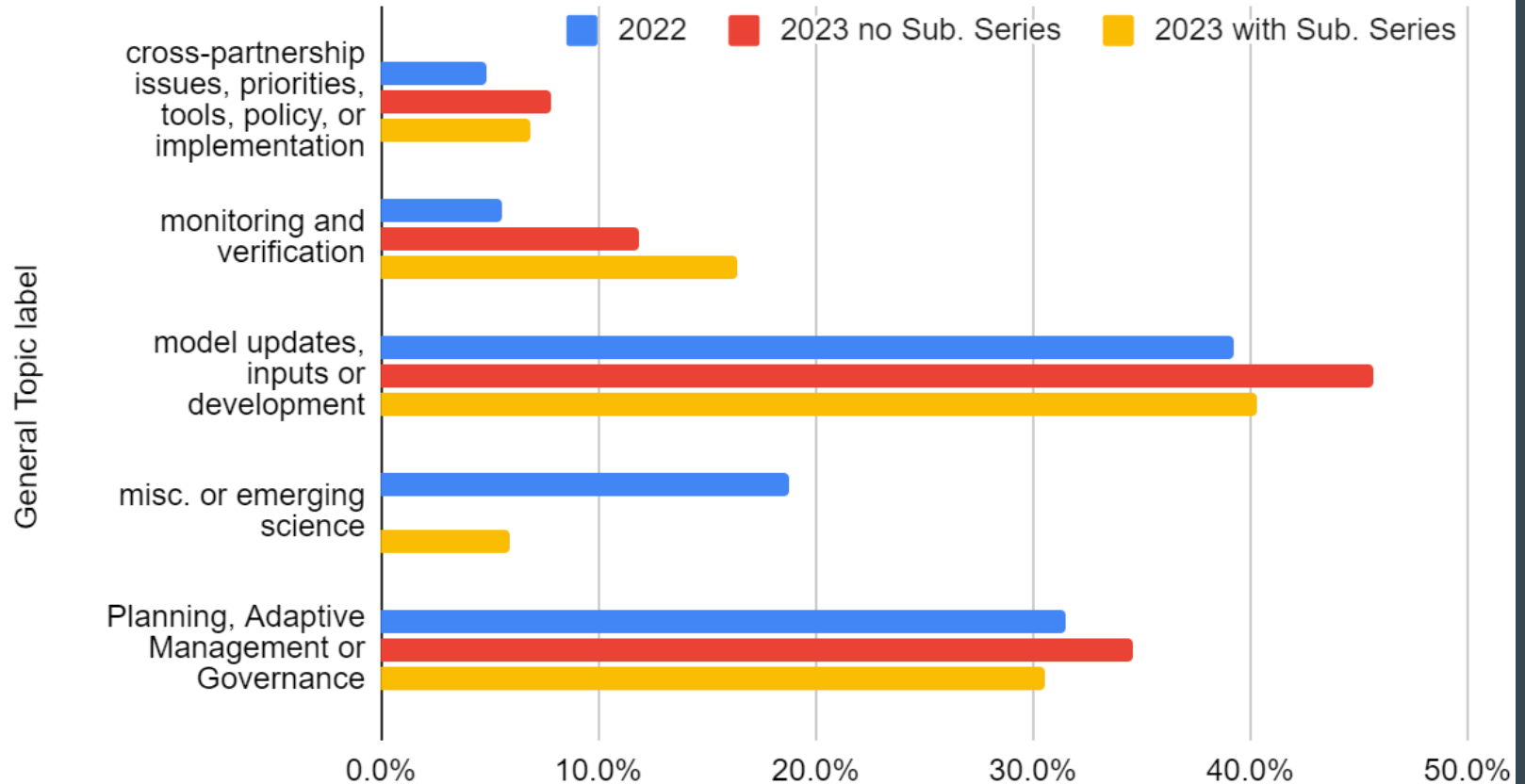
# Overview from Submersion Series (continued)
