The Economic Report

Every year, thousands of visitors come to the Shenandoah Valley to see the fall foliage, spending roughly \$750 per family, to do so.

Air Pollution Treatment

Three Scenarios

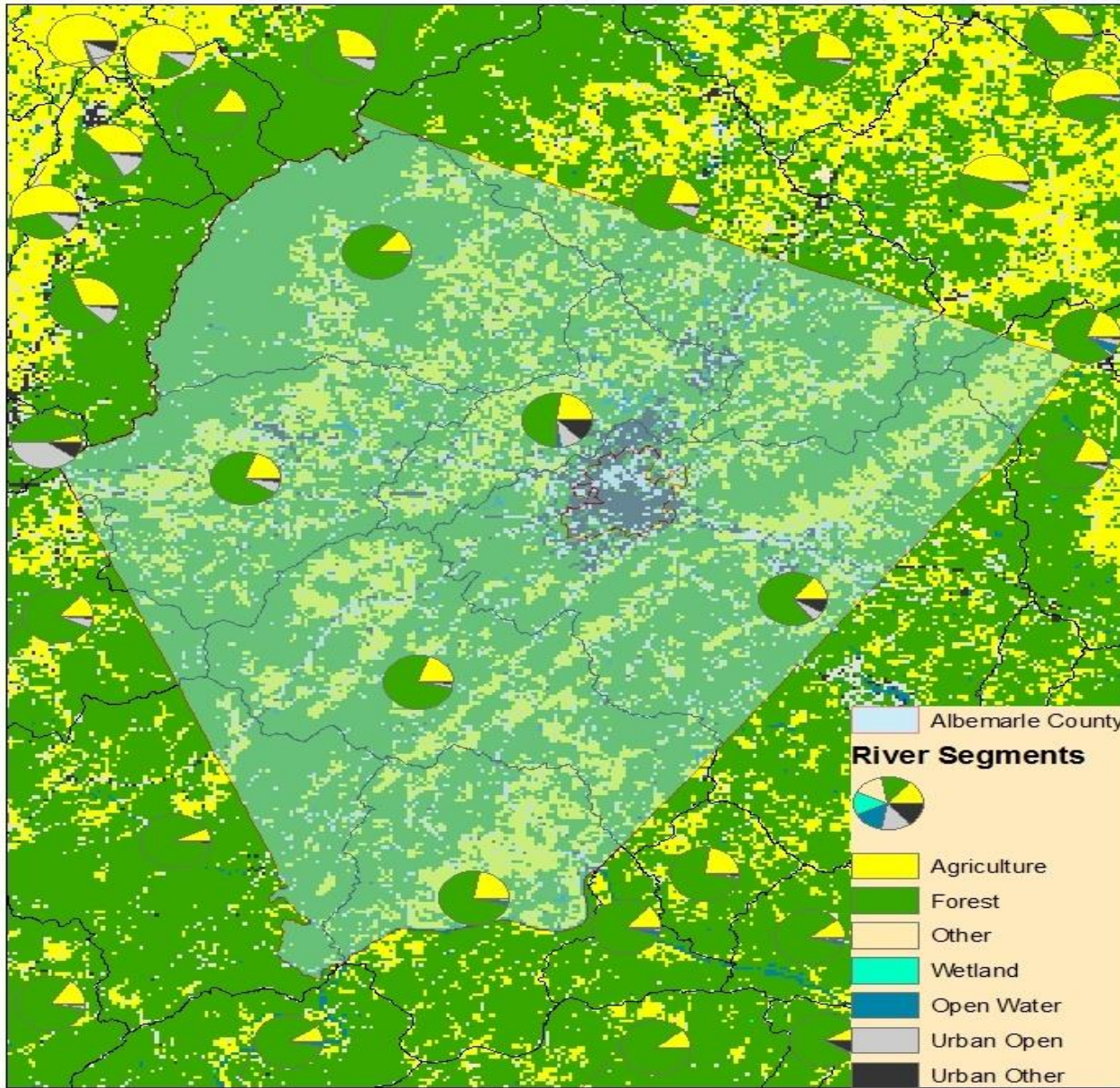
- The present-day dollar value of natural benefits for the watershed (based on 2009 pre-Blueprint)
- The dollar value of the same services post-Blueprint
- Estimate of what we lose if we don't fully implement the Blueprint ("Business as usual")



Approach

- Quantify habitats of Chesapeake Bay watershed (acres, baseline and projected)
- Adjust health of habitats based on pollution loads and expected changes to dissolved oxygen
- Apply “benefits transfer method” to assign value to benefits associated with each habitat (\$/acre/yr)





7 types of habitat

1,100 + land/river segments

We chose 8 natural benefits most likely to be affected by the Clean Water Blueprint

Open water, Forests

Water Supply

Forests, Wetlands

Waste Treatment

Forests, Open water

Water regulation

Wetland, Urban other

Examples

Implementation of Blueprint will have 2 primary effects:

1. **Changes in acres of the various habitats**
e.g., increases in higher value habitats like forests
2. **Improved condition of existing habitats and their services** (e.g., increased Bay DO results in more food production, reduced nitrogen pollution means healthier wetlands that can better reduce flooding)

Approach

Apply “comps”: \$/acre/year

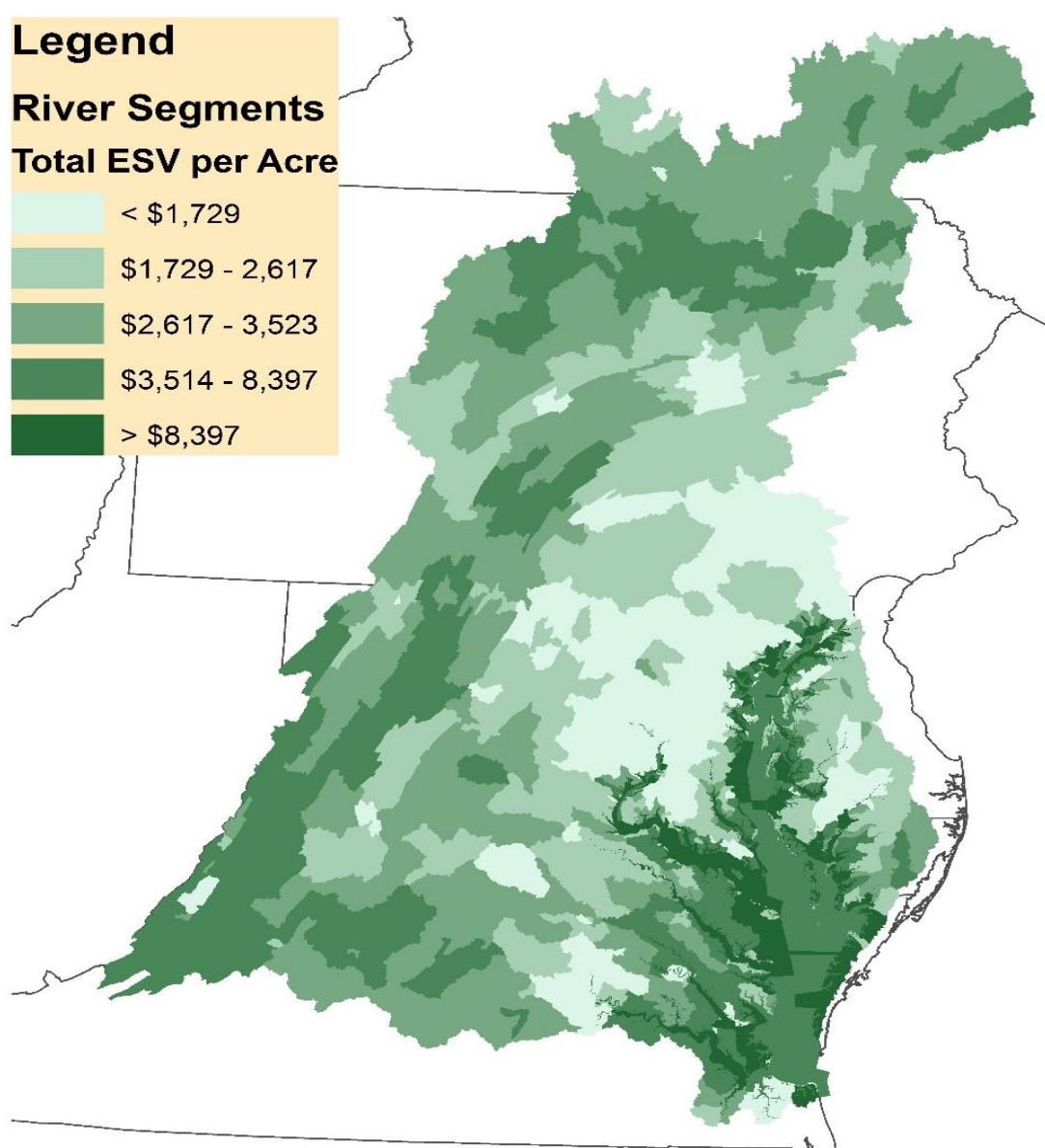
- 8 services

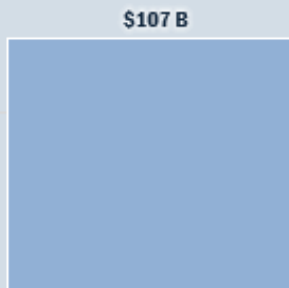
Blueprint Scenario

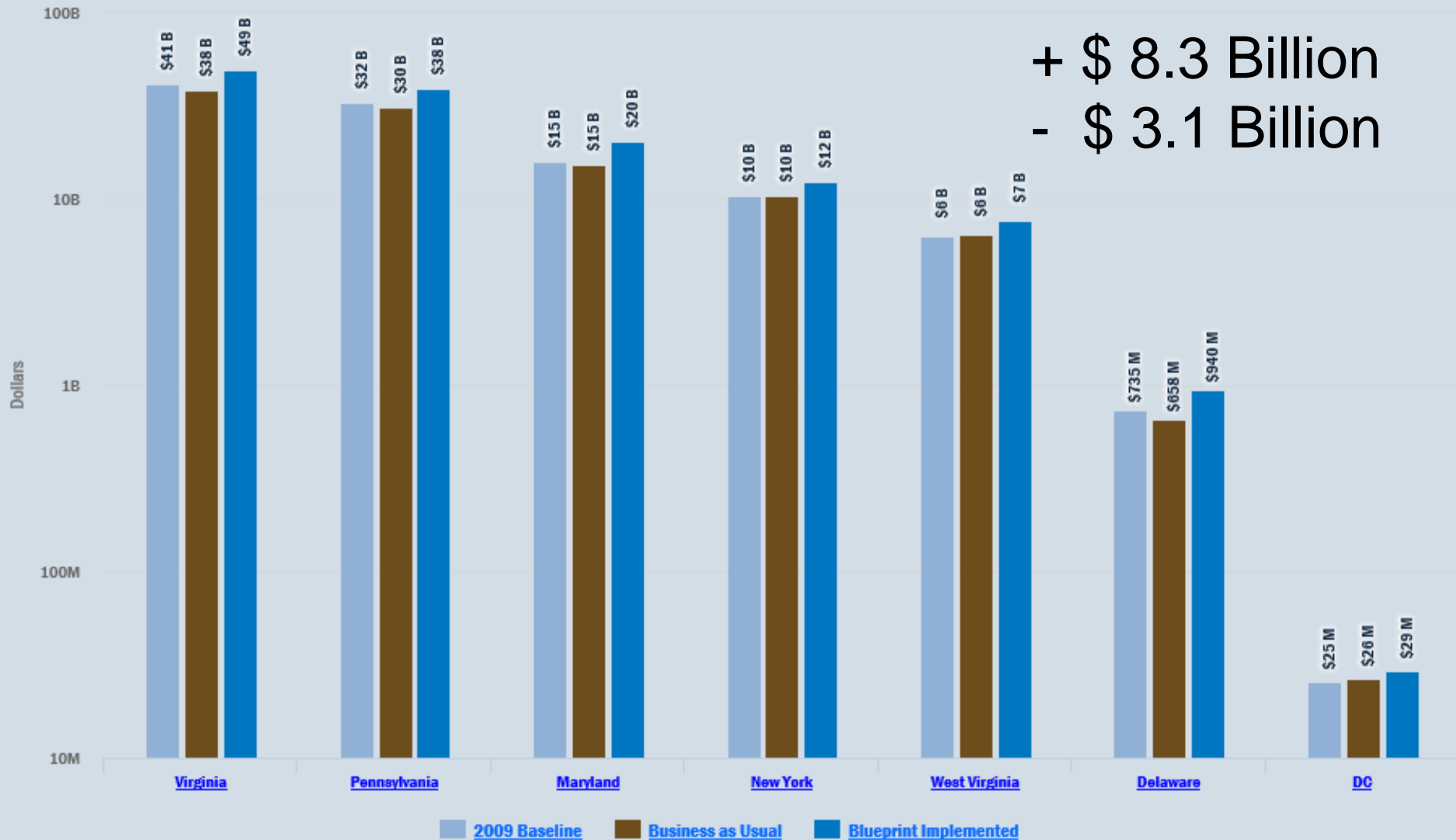

The Value of Natural Benefits by State

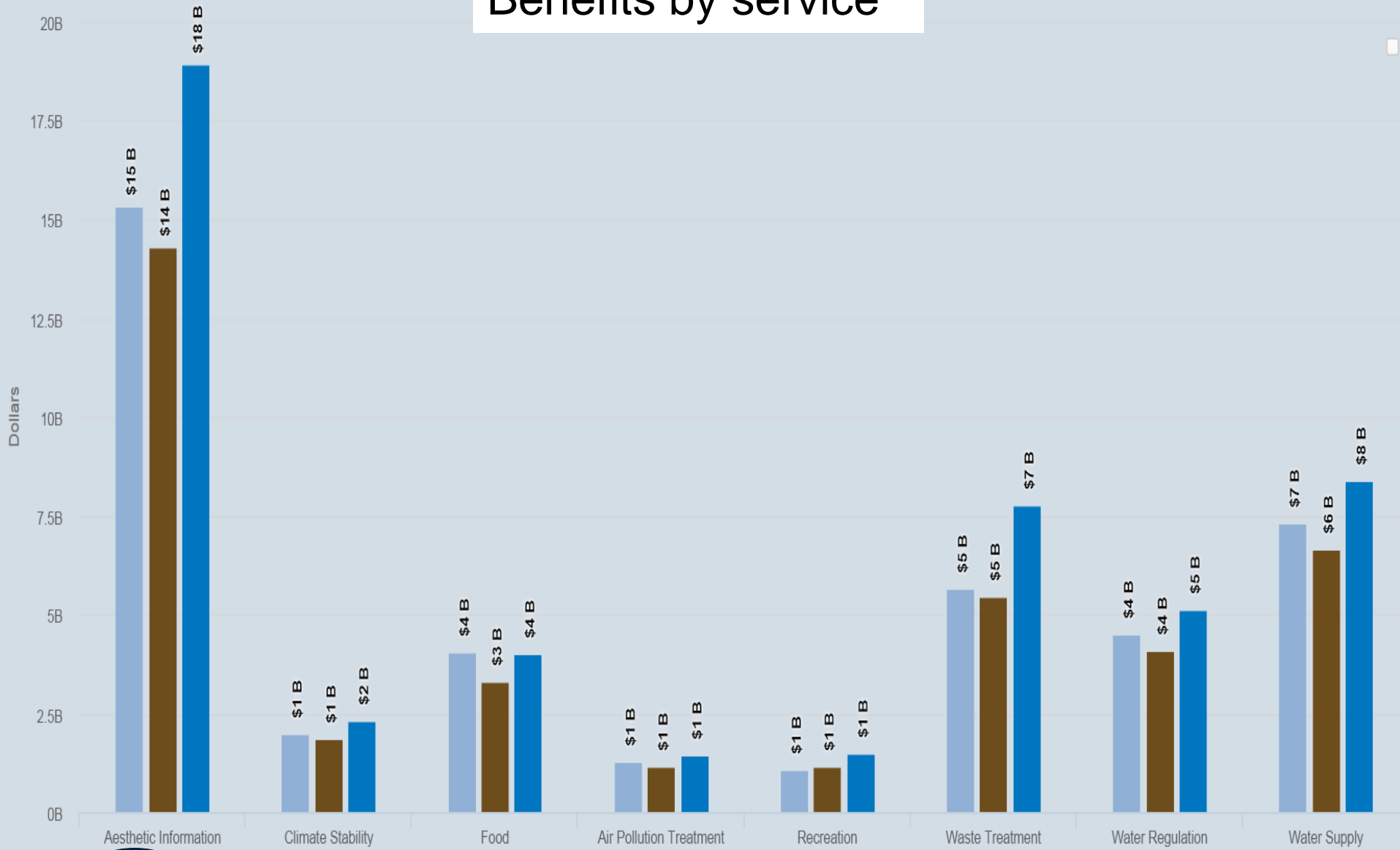

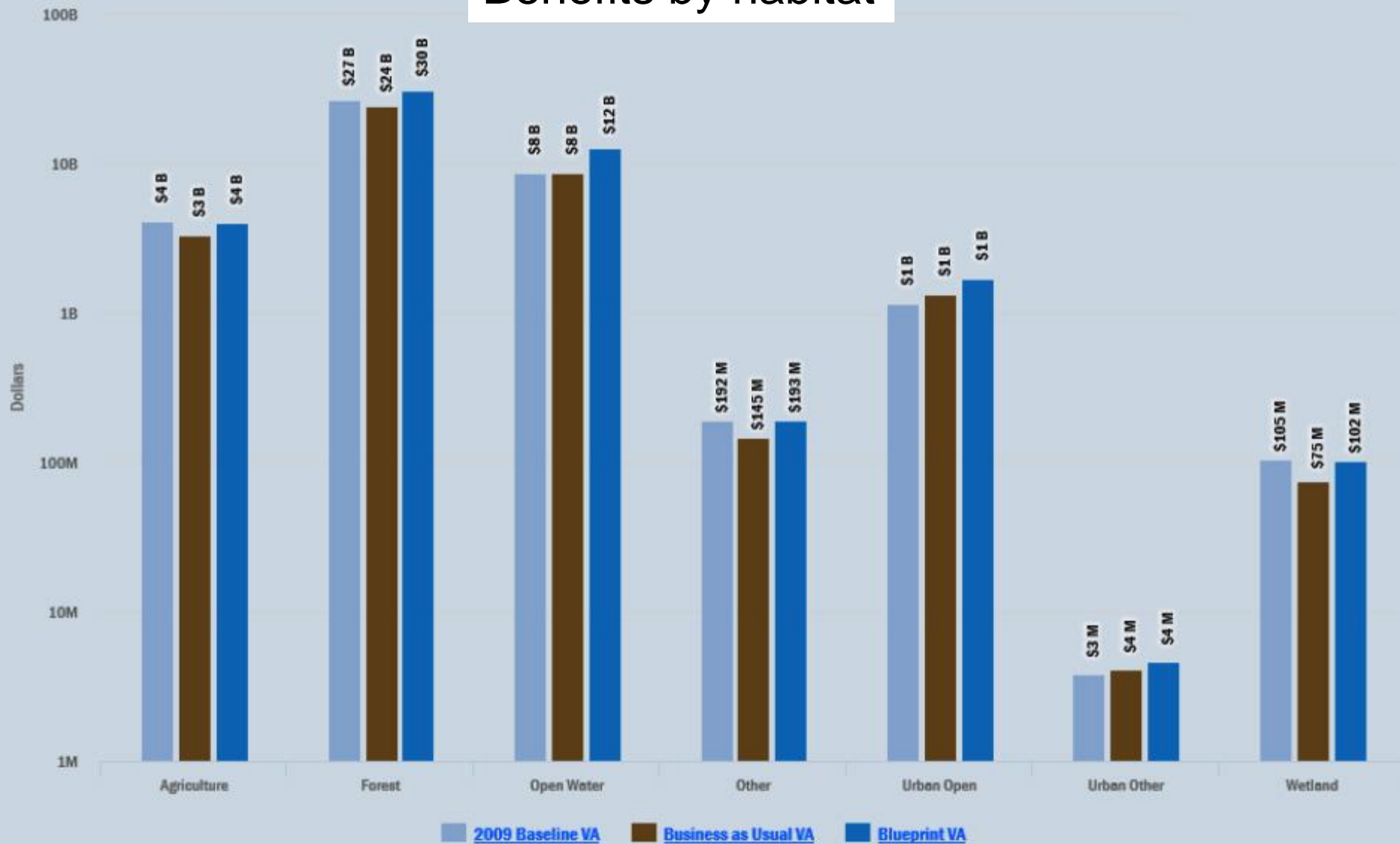
