Water Quality Standards Indicator and Component Pieces – Liza Hernandez (Coordinator)
Water Quality Standards Indicator Presentation

Liza Hernandez demonstrated how the Water Quality Standards (WQS) indicator, and its components, will be featured on the Bay Program's website. The WQS indicator is an integrated baywide measure of dissolved oxygen, chlorophyll a and water clarity/underwater grasses standards attainment. On the Chesapeake Bay Program Data Hub anyone can download the data used for this indicator.

ACTION: TMAW approval is requested for the exchange of the independent water quality criteria indicators for the combined water quality standards indicator. Recommendations from TMAW will be presented to STAR and the WQGIT prior to seeking final approval from the MB of the recommended changes.
