Date	Step
August 1, 2016	CBT comments on GIT proposals provided to respective GITs.
August 2, 2016	GIT Coordinators/Staffers will discuss the process for final prioritization of projects. Agree on final criteria and how to weight the criteria.
August 5, 2016	GITs submit all final proposals and costs. This includes screening proposals for redundancies, as well as alternate methods of implementation, funding, or capacity.
August 10, 2016	GIT Coordinators/Staffers conduct final review and rank proposals in the priority group that the funding line intersects, using the criteria as set on August 2.
August 16, 2016	GIT Chairs select final projects.
Mid-August, 2016	GIT Chairs present final list to CBPO Director. CBPO Director notifies Chairs and MB of final approved projects list.
September 15, 2016	GIT leads finalize scopes of work.
October 2016	Trust issues Request for Proposals to seek bidders.
November 2016	Bid from contractors due. Trust releases for external peer review.
December 2016	Trust compiles reviews. Works with GIT leads to identify winning bidders, initiate sub-award contracts.
January 2017	GIT leads meet with awardees to commence.
