A naming convention:

- New Pasture High and Hay high land uses were created.
- We retained the existing Pasture and Other Hay categories.
- But the existing naming conventions for "split" land uses are Low and High (Specialty High vs Specialty Low)
- Therefore, we propose the existing <u>Pasture</u> and <u>Other Hay</u> land uses should be <u>renamed</u> as <u>Pasture Low</u> and <u>Hay</u>
 <u>Low</u>.
