Before coming to EPA, Adam was the Director of the Montgomery County Maryland Department of Environmental Protection, where he launched programs boosting recycling, curbside compost collection, building energy efficiency standards, and ecological targeting to watershed restoration projects with a focus on equity.

Previously, Adam was the Director of the Department of Environment for Prince George's County, Maryland, where he led the county to the highest recycling rate in the state and led a \$100M public-private green infrastructure construction program focusing on small and minority business development. He served in the administration of Governor Martin O'Malley and at the Department of Labor under former Secretary Tom Perez. Adam also served three terms as Mayor of Edmonston, Maryland.
