**Meeting location:** National Arboretum, 3501 New York Ave NE, Washington, DC 20002

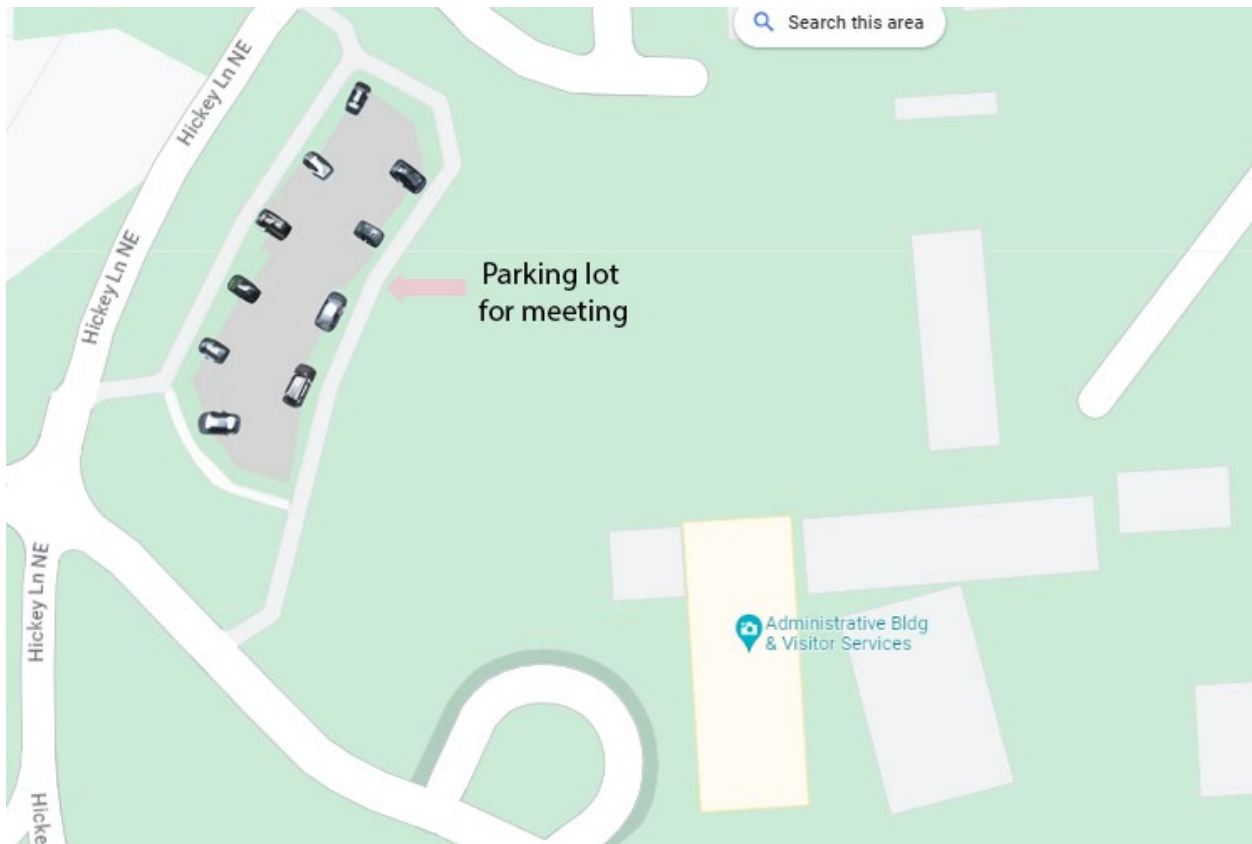
### Transportation:

The National Arboretum is located in the northeast section of Washington, DC, approximately ten minutes from the Capitol Building. There are two entrances: one at 3501 New York Avenue, NE, and the other at 24th & R Streets, NE, off of Bladensburg Road. The R Street entrance is CLOSED to incoming automobile visitor traffic after 2:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday and all-day Fridays and weekends.

The closest Metrorail subway stop is Stadium Armory Station on the Blue and Orange lines. Transfer to Metrobus B-2; disembark the bus on Bladensburg Road and walk 2 blocks to R Street. Make a right on R Street and continue 2 blocks to the Arboretum gates.

### Parking:

There will be reserved parking spaces for EC members/designees ONLY at the parking lot near the Visitors Center. I will share the exact location of the parking spots when they have been confirmed by the Arboretum's staff.



## Walking tour:

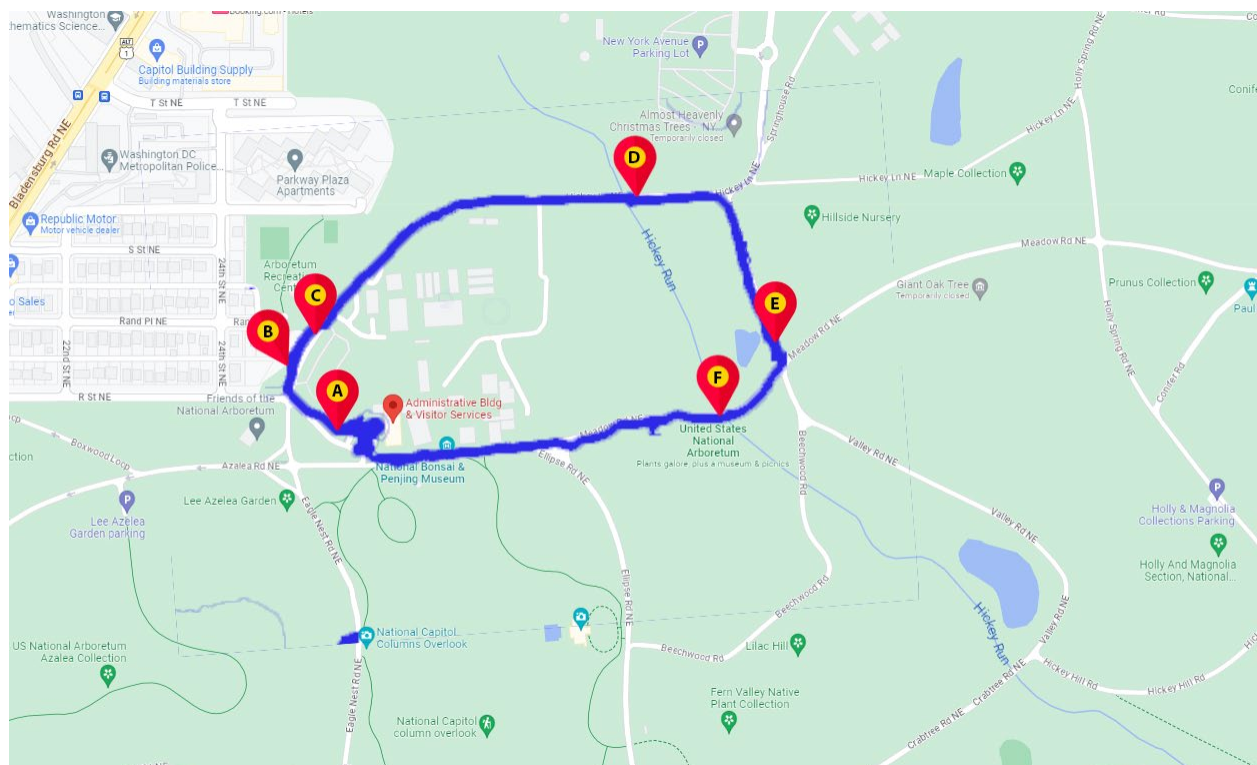
The walking tour will follow Hickey Lane NE to Valley Road NE to Meadow Road NE. The route will start at the Administrative & Visitors Center building and loop back to the original location. There will be six stops along the route showing different elements of existing and future restoration projects.

The stops include:

- Examples of stormwater capture projects in front of the Administrative Building & Visitors Center.
- A submerged gravel wetland that helps control stormwater on the main road of the Arboretum.
- Parking lot retrofit projects.
- The concrete walls surrounding Hickey Run where it flows into the Arboretum grounds.
- The Springhouse Run restoration site.
- The area where Hickey Run and Springhouse Run merge into one stream.

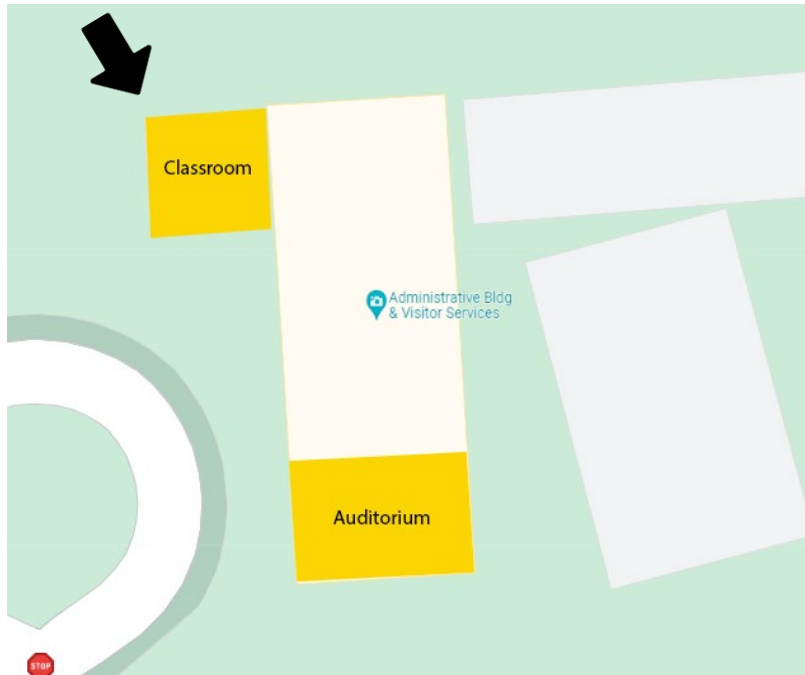
