She received a PhD in Ocean, Earth, and Atmospheric Sciences at Old Dominion University in 2008. At HRPDC, she monitors Chesapeake Bay Program (CBP) developments and Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) implementation for the member localities within the Bay watershed. She is the co-chair of CBP's Land Use Workgroup, a local government representative for the Urban Stormwater Workgroup, and a member of the BMP ad-hoc Verification Team. She has also participated in regulatory and stakeholder advisory groups and the BMP Clearinghouse committee for Virginia's Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), and communicated issues and concerns between the HRPDC member localities, DEQ, and the Virginia Municipal Stormwater Association (VAMSA). Dr. Filippino has been a participant at Water Quality GIT meetings over the last 4 years, and looks forward to providing a local government perspective to the partnership.
