

#### **Next Steps**


From 2024 Charge –

The Chesapeake Executive Council charges the Principals' Staff Committee with recommending this simplified and streamlined partnership structure and processes to the Chesapeake Executive Council in as much detail as possible by December 1, 2025. Subsequent changes that incorporate this revised structure and processes into the Governance and Management Framework for the Chesapeake Bay Program do not need to occur until June 2026.



#### **Next Steps**

By July 1, 2026, the Principals' Staff Committee will finalize the membership, leadership, responsibilities and decision-making protocols associated with these two structural components. However, to align with the revised Chesapeake Bay Watershed Agreement and ensure timely delivery of Management Strategies, the partnership will begin preparing for—and transitioning to--the new Goal Team structure following the December 2, 2025 Executive Council meeting.




#### **Next Steps**
