NFWF INSR Grant

- Applied back in fall of 2024
- Recently received word that it will be awarded however still waiting official word from NFWF.
- Grant timing- 3 years
- Funding ~\$488k

SRBC Role

- Hire CWIP coordinator through competitive RFP Process (in next 3-6 months).
 - This will be dependent on a fully executed grant with NFWF
- Manage CWIP coordinator activities, extend capacity of the coordinator and/or CWIP steering group as needed

CWIP Coordinator Role/Responsibilities

- Serve as primary coordinator for CWIP implementation and public-facing point-of-contact
- Provide outreach and coordination support for CWIP implementation, serving as the liaison between the CWIP steering group and local communities/partnerships
- Conduct a needs and gap analysis for improving implementation strategies, considering best strategies/tools employed to date, local partnerships, challenges/obstacles, etc.

CWIP Coordinator Role/Responsibilities (cont.)

- Seek funding sources and assemble proposals/partnerships for implementation work
- Implement select set of strategies/projects as defined by recommendations, and feasible given funding acquired
- Technical and Administrative Support-
 - Track nitrogen reductions
 - Assist with reporting
 - Avoid Duplication with stat WIPs
 - Use BMP Opportunity Analysis tools to target high impact projects

Position Structure

- This position will report directly to SRBC staff
- The CWIP Steering committee will also have oversight role in high level activities of this position.
