To build individual organization and collaborative capacity to advance Chesapeake Bay restoration at the local, community level.


History

- Designed around needs self-identified by the environmental non-profit community














Administering the Capacity Building Initiative

- Applications are reviewed and scored by an external technical review committee
- The application and RFP are adapted each year based on feedback
- The Trust works to make the program as accessible as possible to all groups, regardless of previous federal grant experience







Why We Focus on Capacity

- Provide the skills and systems to manage complex projects, and deliver high quality
- Stronger alignment reduces duplication of effort and competition for resources











Program Impact
