### 11:20 Crediting NRCS practices (20 min) NRCS funding Initiative

L. Tillman, V. Van Note

In <u>May</u>, the AgWG endorsed proposed changes to the Phase 6 NEIEN appendix for select NRCS practices identified as mapping to Soil and Water Conservation Plans in the Phase 5 NEIEN appendix. The proposed changes would shift these practices from "draft" to "release" status so that they could receive pollutant reduction credit towards the TMDL. Final approval of changes in the NEIEN appendix was requested at the <u>August WTWG</u> meeting, however the WTWG expressed concerns related to the crediting of the individual practices. Leon Tillman, USDA-NRCS, and Vanessa Van Note, WTWG Coordinator, will summarize WTWG feedback.
