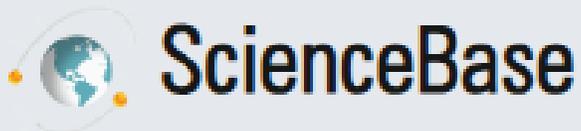

- Focused initially on development of products to guide data management processes



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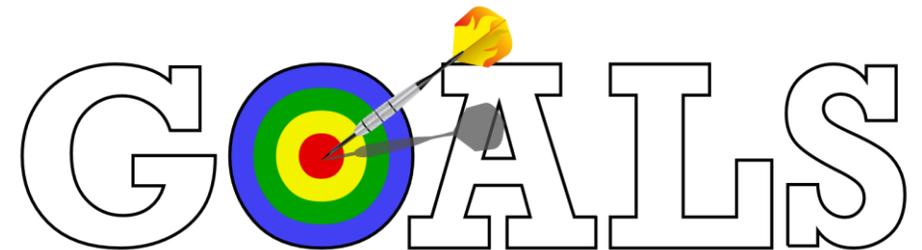
Workgroup Goals

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CBPO Guiding Principles

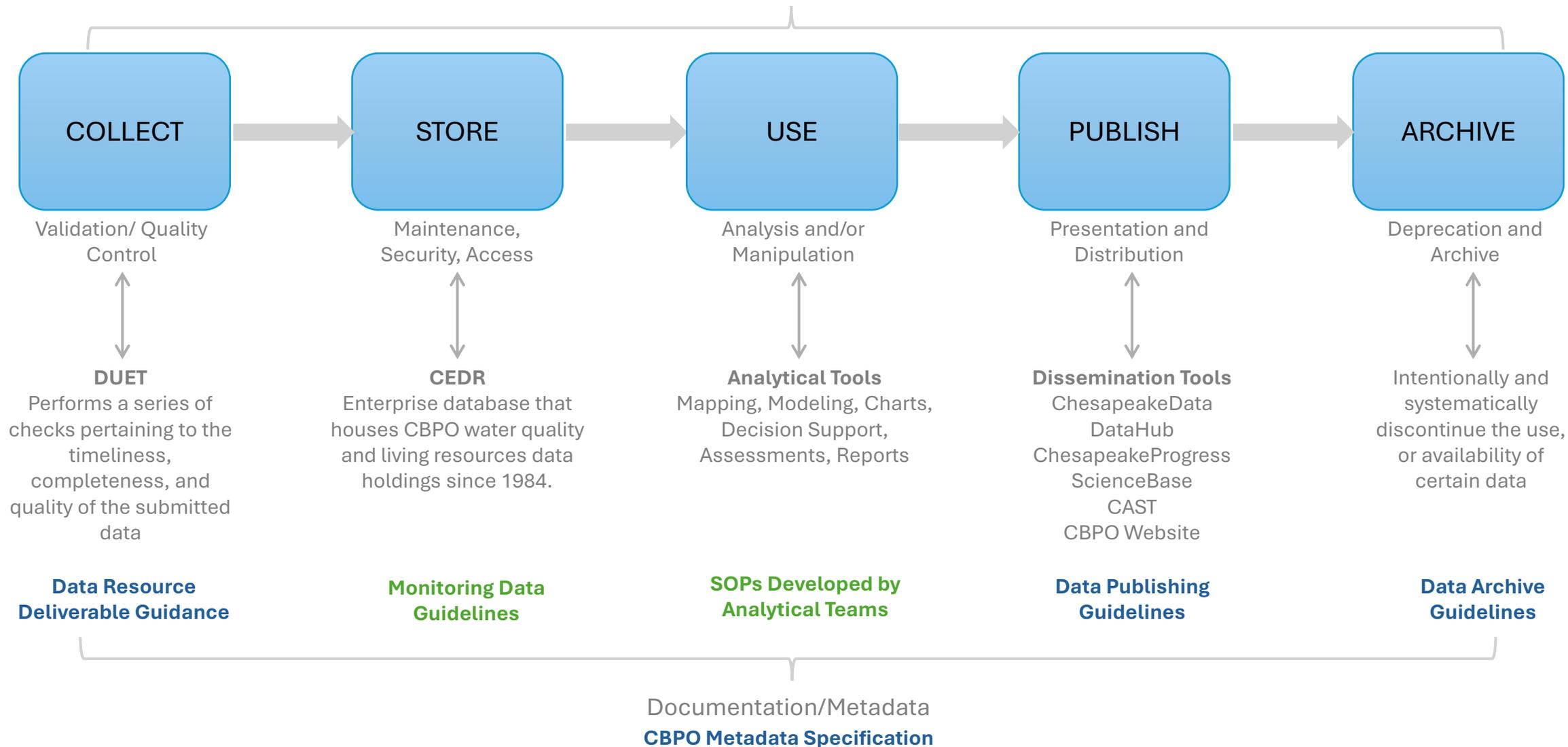


Principle	Description
Discovery and Accessibility	The CBPO will enable stakeholders to effectively and efficiently find, access, and use data resources by making them easily accessible and in non-proprietary formats, where possible.
Classification	The CBPO will promote data classification by utilizing standardized, rich, and consistent metadata with federal and agency guidance to enable users to discover, access, evaluate, and use the data resources.
Quality	The CBPO will ensure data resources used and shared are of known quality. The CBPO will ensure, to the extent possible, data resources are complete, timely, accurate, authentic, and valid.
Data Standards	The CBPO will facilitate cross-organizational collaboration, data resources sharing, and integration by promoting data resource consistency and reusability across partners and platform systems.
Value	The CBPO will ensure data resources are relevant and aligned with its mission, strategic plan, capabilities, and lifecycle data management needs. The CBPO will prioritize efforts to address data resource gaps and needs.
Transparency	The CBPO will provide visibility into the processes and methods used to collect, store, manage, and publish data resources.
Interoperability	The CBPO will promote common data resources, architecture, standards, processes and technologies across partners and platforms. To the extent possible, CBPO will identify authoritative data resource systems and establish common data schemas.

These principles will be used to develop the policies, procedures, and standards that will form the backbone of our data governance program.

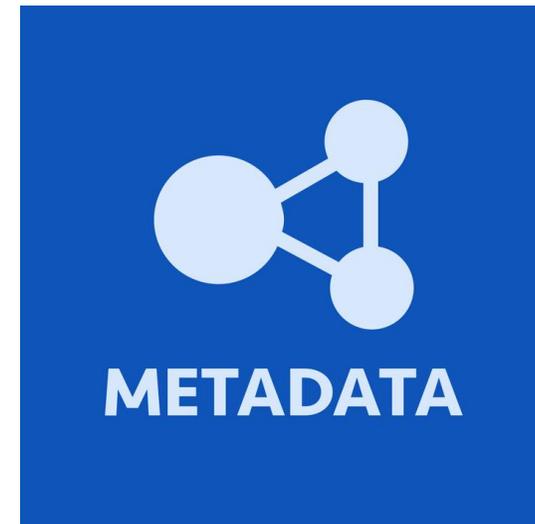

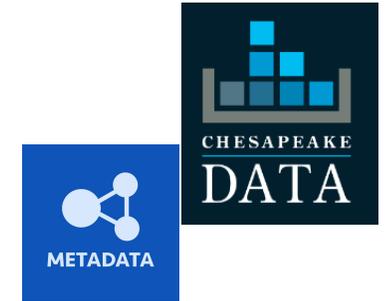

The 1-meter Land Use/Land Cover Change Viewer is a three-panel viewer depicting land use/land cover change from 2013/14 to 2017/18. The viewer was developed to support the release of the 2022 edition of the Chesapeake Bay Program's 1-meter LULC and change data. The first two panels show the National Agriculture Imagery Program imagery used for the change analysis, while the third panel overlays the data, indicating areas with land use change.

Level 1: StoryMaps, Documents, Reports, Graphics, Visual Presentations

Includes basic identification information to support discovery and access to data resources

Level 2: Tabular Data without Spatial Coordinates

Includes data quality and attribute information to support user needs for analytical and visual interpretation

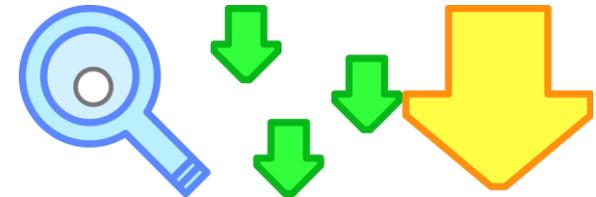
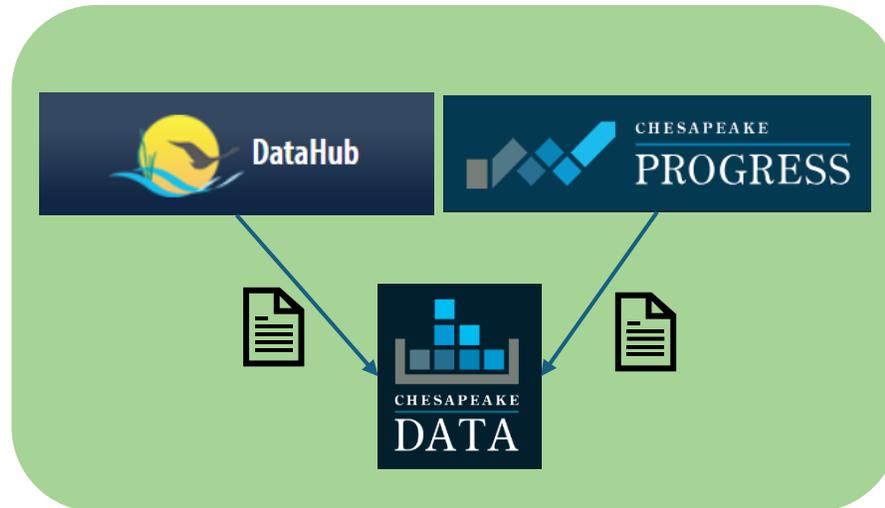
Level 3: Geospatial Data Layers and Tabular Data with Spatial Coordinates

Includes spatial reference information and positional accuracy to support user needs for mapping, modeling and analysis

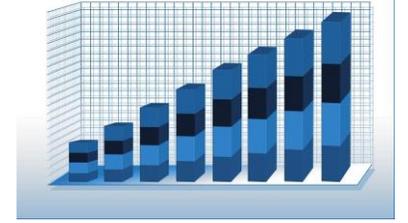


Level 1- Purpose and Applicability

- Original CIMS Definition
 - The purpose of Level 1 Metadata is to provide for the desired **search functionality**.
 - The elements in Level 1 metadata will furnish the minimum information about a dataset or document required to **search for and select** a particular dataset or document, to view and download.



Level 2 - Purpose and Applicability



- Original CIMS Definition
 - The elements in Level 2 metadata are required to query and analyze the tabular data in CIMS. This level of metadata are not usually needed for nontechnical documents.
 - Level 2 contains those metadata elements in Level 1 as well as additional elements from sections 2 and 5 - **Data Quality** and **Entity & Attribute Information**
- Applicable to tabular datasets that are not spatially referenced.
 - Geospatial or spatially referenced data are data that contain coordinates (e.g., latitude and longitude).
 - Non-geospatial data or data that are not spatially referenced are data that do not include coordinates in the data itself.

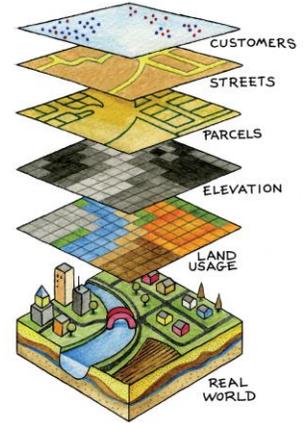
Level 2 - Elements



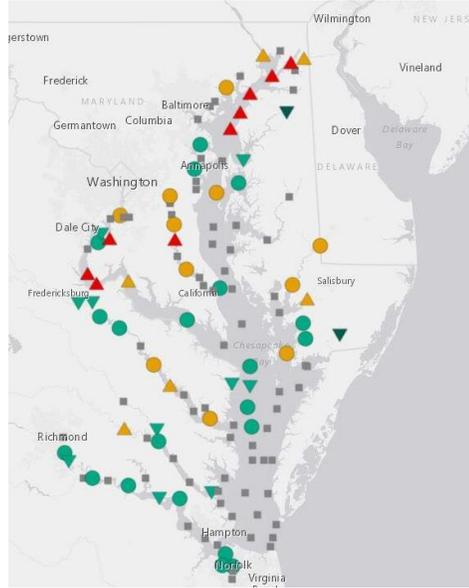
- Data Quality
 - Attribute accuracy
 - Logical consistency (*an explanation of the fidelity of relationships in the data set and tests used. Is it needed for level 2?*)
 - Completeness of data
 - Data lineage – all the steps that happened to create the current data set
- Entity and Attribute Information
 - Provide detailed attributes in metadata
 - Provide a link to a published attribute look up table/document

Level 3 - Purpose and Applicability



- Original CIMS Definition
 - The purpose of level 3 metadata is to begin to provide the information necessary to initiate queries and analyses of **spatially referenced data** including tabular datasets with coordinates, maps, and GIS coverages.
 - The elements in Level 3 metadata will supply the information about a dataset necessary to **query and analyze a particular dataset or sets.**



Level 3 - Elements

- Horizontal Positional Accuracy Report
- Vertical Positional Accuracy Report (where applicable)
- Spatial Data Organization Information (vector/raster)
- Spatial Reference Information (coordinate system)

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Data Resource Deliverable Guidance

- **Data, Information and Document Delivery Requirements:** Describes how data resource content should be delivered to CBPO, including acceptable data formats.
- **Deliverable Serving vs. Submission Requirements:** Describes requirements for electronic data submission and service provision.
- **Geospatial Data Requirements:** Describes requirements for submitting data that contains geospatial coordinates.
- **CBPO Metadata Specification:** Describes requirements for data documentation.
- **Numeric Data Reporting Guideline:** Describes requirements for reporting numeric information, including value precision, true zeros, missing data, and parameters not sampled.
- **Date and Time Guideline:** Describes requirements for reporting date and time information.
