Context

Why remote sensing?

- Remote sensing has been/continues to be a focus of the partnership
 - Understandably so: "... the process of detecting and monitoring the physical characteristics of an area by measuring its reflected and emitted radiation at a distance (typically from satellite or aircraft)."
 - Time, cost savings
 - Critical piece of discussions about the future

Why remote sensing?

- Remote sensing has been a focus of the AgWG:
 - Remote sensing guidance document (2017), pilot projects, mentioned in BMP expert panel reports
 - More information available on BMP Verification Framework Updates webpage
