

PROPOSED PUBLIC FEEDBACK REVIEW PROCESS

CBP Communications Office will enter comments into a master spreadsheet, similar to the Phase One process. Comments will be grouped into the following:

- Goal One
- Goal Two
- Goal Three
- Goal Four
- Overview Watershed Agreement structure (e.g., Vision, Principles, Preamble)
- Editorial comments
- Out of scope
- Miscellaneous (requires full group review and discussion)

Divide and conquer!

• Reviewers will split into five groups—one for each of the revised four agreement goals and the outcomes underneath them, and one for comments pertaining to the other portions of the Watershed Agreement.

- Feedback will be reviewed on a rolling basis.
- Small teams will meet in mid-July and end of July (as a start).
- Full group will meet the first week of August.
- Synopsis of public feedback will be presented at the August Management Board meeting.
- Reviewers encouraged to clear their schedules September 2-5 to devote to feedback review.
- Overview of feedback to be presented at September Management Board meeting.

** Reviewers encouraged to work with Subject Matter Experts throughout the review process.
