


The Impact of Boundaries




 There are 1,059 Small MS4 Regulated Municipalities Across the State


PA MS4 Communities




MS4 Vs. Population






Population Impacts



MS4 Vs. Landform






Landform Impacts



Permit Renewal at 5 Year Increments


Potential Changes:

REASONING


- Standardizes evaluation criteria
