NEIEN Progress Data Storage Policy

Current Policy

- All submitted data sets are stored indefinitely even if only one record is changed.
- This is done so older datasets can be recovered and set back to "Is Current".
- Disc space is rapidly filling with progress BMP submissions, and it is unsustainable going forward.

Proposed Data Storage Policy

- All datasets where “Is Current” = True will be saved.
- All datasets submitted during the current and last year's progress period are saved.
- All other datasets will be deleted.
- This will be run at the end of the progress period when the scenario is made official

Example: 2025 Progress

- When the 2025 Progress scenario is made official:
 - All submissions made prior to September 1, 2024, where “Is Current” = False will be deleted.
 - This leaves all datasets, no matter the submission date, where “Is Current” = True AND Any dataset submitted during the 2024 and 2025 progress periods where “Is Current” = False.
- You always have access to the BMP data in your state systems for re-submission at any time.
