PSC Decision #2 and Agriculture fertilizer update

Tom will brief the WQGIT on the latest developments from the Fertilizer Expert Group (FEG).

PSC Decision #2 (from <u>August 2022</u>): The partnership will convene a committee to develop short-term, interim resolutions to fertilizer data concerns before moving forward with CAST 2021 as well as long-term resolutions for Phase 7 model. The committee will report out on progress towards this action at the next PSC meeting.

Informational. The plan is to seek a WQGIT consensus decision at our July 24 meeting.

PSC Decision #3

Cassie and Ruth will review the Watershed Technical Workgroup's recommendations developed in response to the Decision 3 charge.

PSC Decision #3 (from <u>August 2022</u>): The partnership will update the process for incorporating data into CAST to include additional safeguards to prevent data analysis errors and to assess reasonability of modeling results after CBP protocols are applied.
