Currently, I'm a Compliance Program Manager at the USDA. I'm in the Environmental Management Division in the Office of Leasing, Operations, and Property Management. I advise the following agencies on environmental compliance: Forest Service, Agricultural Research Service, Agricultural Marketing Service, Animal and Plant Health Inspection Service, Farm Production and Conservation, Food Safety and Inspection Service, and Rural Development. I manage the USDA Environmental Compliance Enforcement Dashboard, an interactive tool allowing users to view compliance information for environmentally permitted USDA-owned facilities. Data from the dashboard is sourced from publicly available data from the EPA's ECHO database. I have advised on the CERCLA cleanup strategy, approach, and risk factors, CAA and Title V Permitting obligations, RCRA reporting obligations, and EPCRA 304/CERCLA 103 chemical release reporting. Prior to joining the USDA, I was a regional coordinator/team lead at the EPA's Office of Superfund Remediation and Technology Innovation in Washington, DC. I advised on CERCLA policy regarding remedy decisions for cleanup efforts in several regions. I also worked as a Superfund remedial project manager as well as an EPCRA enforcement engineer for EPA Region 4 in Atlanta, GA. I led site cleanup projects, developed and established remedial alternatives, guided contractors and project teams, and negotiated task order contracts with consultants. I have worked as a RCRA compliance officer as well as an air permitting engineer with the Georgia Environmental Protection Division. I have also worked as an air dispersion modeler for an environmental consulting firm in Atlanta, GA. I earned my Bachelor of Science in Chemical Engineering from the Georgia Institute of Technology in Atlanta, GA.
