TMAW will continue discussions on BASIN related topics based on follow-up research preformed by TMAW members after the February meeting. TMAW will follow up on discussion topics from the previous meeting, though the March meeting will focus on the first topic of Monitoring the Mainstem of the Bay most effectively, partnership-wide.

- 1) Monitoring the Mainstem of the Bay focused on achieving more accurate DO assessments in a 2-3 day window.
- 2) Citizen Monitoring: Can it be integrated into our monitoring program? If so, how?
- 3) Shallow water monitoring: How to transition to the next phase (Ad Hoc Team).
