# 9:10 <u>Proposed Scenarios for the Partial Credit Recommendation,</u> *Ted Tessler and Kate Bresaw, PA DEP.*

In response to the action item from the December Meeting (*Action: PA DEP will develop reporting and tracking scenarios for partial credit for inclusion in the partial credit recommendation*), Ted Tessler and Kate Bresaw reviewed proposed scenarios to consider how partial credit may be applied in the model. #### Discussion

Kate Bresaw: An additional question - if during an inspection we were able to identify the practice as originally being funded and implemented by USDA, but we now have the locational data associated with the practice, does it still qualify for partial credit?

Jill Whitcomb: Is PA the only state that is having these problems? Or do we just have them more frequently because we rely on federal data more than others?

James Martin: VA has similar challenges.

Alana Hartman: In WV we have trouble just reporting the NRCS stream restoration. We usually rely on the practices that are funded by other entities. In the past few years I came across someone in the Corps who could look up old permit documents for us which was helpful. I can forward the info to you.

Jennifer Walls (in chat): Delaware has this challenge as well.
