WHAT WOULD YOU LIKE TO SEE WITH AN ADAPTATION OUTCOME WORKGROUP?

Possibly look at existing plans to implement nature-based solutions as a template for the seven subwatersheds

Select focus areas that are at different starting points (not all have to start at ground zero)

Considering how to extract and share "lessons learned" from the more focused work in the subwatersheds

What if some of the communities that are better resourced/more experienced become "mentors" for less resourced communities?

Maybe the seven communities could "train the trainers?"

Matching adaptation options with forecasted predictions (i.e. are communities considering the correct range of solutions given what they're facing)?

Revisiting the recommendations from the climate small group in B25 Phase 1 to see what gaps this group can help fill

Focus on long term costs and effects and not short term costs

Helping to create (or supporting existing) communities of practice for different types or categories of adaptation strategies.
