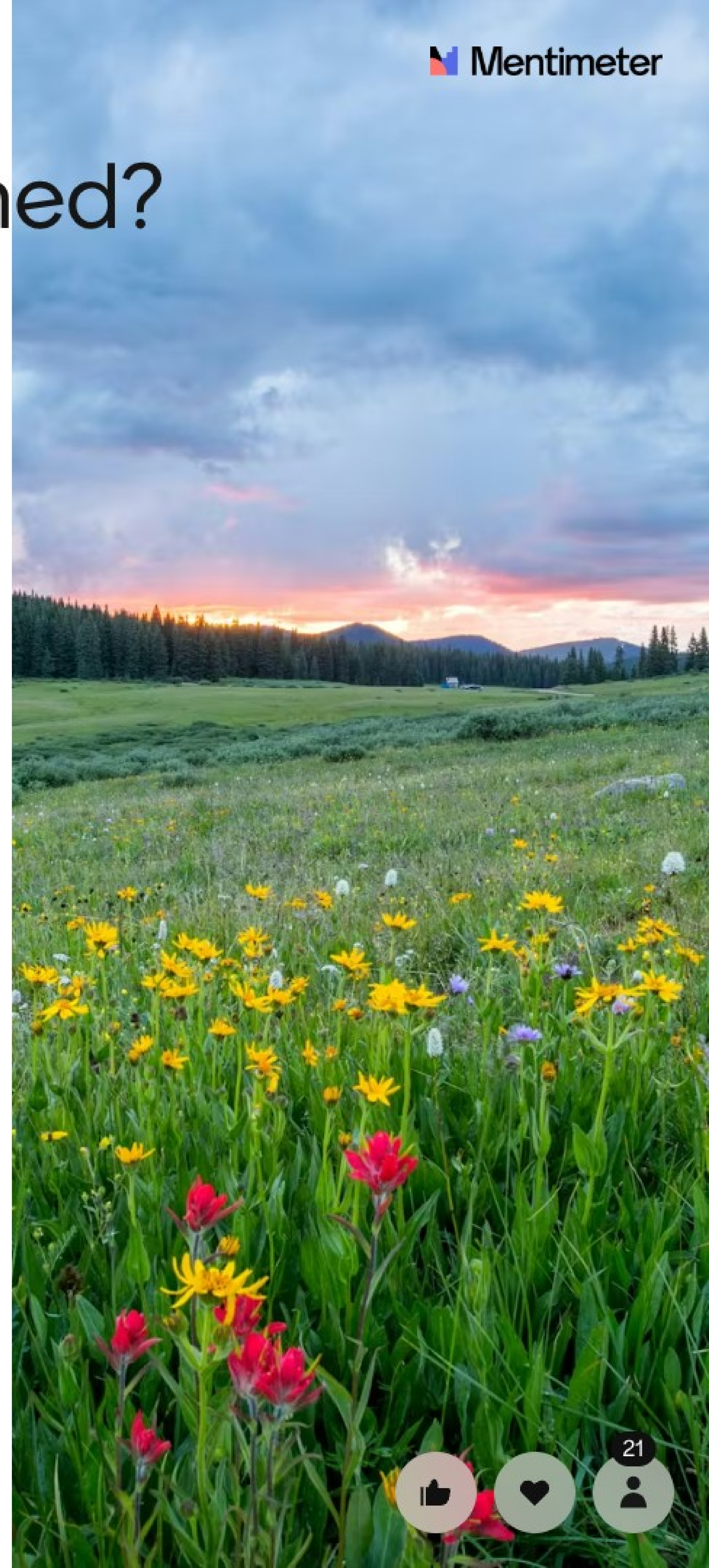

How do YOU define greenspace?

An area of land with pervious surface, habitat for plants and their animal communities, and some degree of access for human users

Natural lands consisting of forests, grasslands, etc.

Greenspace is natural or vegetated land that is conserved or managed to support wildlife, and fisheries, water quality, outdoor recreation, and public access.

public open space with significant native plant cover and wildlife habitat

public vegetated open space outdoors

Outside, vegetated, natural, limited infrastructure

Almost any size natural space that's freely accessible to the public

land use which is 50% or more of forestry, flora, and/or fauna

How do YOU define greenspace?

I think of the song "What a Wonderful World" - trees of green, red roses too, skies of blue - an area where native vegetation thrives

Public open space that is predominantly covered by vegetation

An outdoor area with natural plantings, limited impervious surfaces, and space for open air recreation.

A space of nature set aside for eco-friendly use and enjoyment.

Places that provide opportunity for communities to connect with nature with significant native plant cover

Walkable, accessible, and well-maintained
