**10:15 Update on 2014 Programmatic Milestones for the Urban Sector.** Katherine Antos, CBPO. Attach B.

Katherine will report on EPA's annual evaluation of the progress made by each Bay state and DC in meeting programmatic milestones for the urban sector in 2014. Programmatic milestones include specific commitments by the states to adopt plans, policies, audits, permit compliance activities, capacity-building to increase urban BMP implementation. The WTWG has recently evaluated a proposal to greatly simplify state reporting of urban BMPs built to new state stormwater standards and retrofits. Matt will discuss the revised technical memo that outlines the proposed approach and will solicit feedback from the urban work group on its overall feasibility.
