Chesapeake Bay Program Scientific & Technical Advisory Committee (STAC)

- Timeline:
 - Proposals due to STAC by March 1st, 2013
 - Funding begins June 1st, 2013
 - Workshops must be completed by May, 31st 2014
- Workshop Proposal: Land Use Planning Tool Kit for Citizen Engagement

Fisheries GIT Goals

- Fisheries Outcome: Continue to advance, develop, and apply ecosystem based management tools and communication strategies to improve fisheries health and production by connecting land use decision making across jurisdictions.
- Management Board Comment:
 - Fisheries GIT should reconsider the third outcome since it is not really an outcome but a strategy. An outcome should be measurable and specific (e.g. which specific fisheries and where? Just tidal or nontidal as well?)
- Discussion:
 - Will the proposed outcomes satisfy the Management Board?
 - Anything else the Executive Committee would like to add?
- Outcome:
 - The Executive Committee agrees on the measurable outcomes to incorporate within the Fisheries Outcome.
