#### II. Factors Influencing Forage in the Chesapeake Bay (2:10-2:40pm)

Ryan Woodland will present the status and preliminary findings of the GIT-funded study by the
University of Maryland Center for Environmental Science to investigate the factors influencing
population trends in Chesapeake Bay forage.

### III. Striped Bass Health (2:40-3:10pm)

- Jim Uphoff will provide a presentation on Maryland DNR's work on striped bass indicators.
- Monitoring of Striped Bass health (1998-2014), relative abundance (1983-2014), natural mortality (1987-2014), and forage relative abundance in surveys (1959-2014) and fall diets of Striped Bass (2006-2014) provided five indicators that were summarized into a single score to assess forage status and Striped Bass well-being in Maryland's portion of Chesapeake Bay. Annual scores indicated that threshold (very poor forage conditions) or near threshold conditions prevailed during 1998-2007; favorable conditions (near target to meeting target) predominated during 2008-2010; and status has hovered between avoiding threshold and near threshold conditions, with considerable scatter among individual indicators, through 2016.
