Why do we need funding?

- The path to revise BMP Verification Protocols exists through source sector workgroups; however, given the WQGIT concerns with credit duration, the MB charged the WQGIT with convening an ad-hoc action team.
- This group exists to, first-and-foremost address credit duration and partial/variable credit concerns.
 - Revising existing credit durations will be time and resource intensive (e.g., lit reviews and data collection) as it requires multiple lines of evidence.
 - Any proposed recommended revisions to the current BMP Verification Protocols will need to follow a scientific process, as was the case when the protocols were first established.
- Currently, there is no funding in place to support contractor or grantee work on credit duration.

FUNDING OPTIONS

2019/20 Funding

- This Ad-Hoc Team was not selected for funding via remaining FY19 GIT Funding.
- It is too late for the FY20 Bay grants (CBRAP/CBIG) process unless a jurisdiction would like to amend one of its grants to support this work.

2021 GIT Funding

- GIT Funding is a competitive process that will require submitting a proposal and budget.
- It is not guaranteed that funding will be awarded to this project.

FY 2021 Grant Allocation

 Jurisdictions could use part of their FY21 grant allocation to support the work of this group.



Why is prioritization important?

- While addressing all concerns expressed to date with BMP Verification would be ideal, this
 group does not have the resources to do so at this time.
 - For this reason, until we have addressed all credit duration concerns, we will be focusing on credit duration first-and-foremost per the charge of the Management Board.
- In order to incorporate as many revised credit durations as possible into CAST-21, we need to hone our focus.
 - In order to meet the deliverables and timeline, we need to prioritize a list of BMPs.
 - A more in-depth discussion on prioritization will occur at the September 2020 meeting.
- Any issues with BMP Verification that fall outside of the charge given to this Ad-Hoc Team by the MB over the next two years can still be taken up and addressed through the appropriate source sector workgroups.
