

# September 17, 2020 Draft Actions/Decisions

#### **EC Report Out and Follow-Up**

## A) Incorporating DEIJ Commitments into Partnership Work

**ACTION:** Jim Edward, Wendy O'Sullivan and Tuana Phillips will create a template for jurisdictions and federal agencies to assess current DEIJ efforts which will be distributed to the Management Board. Sections are to be filled out by jurisdiction and agency representatives by **COB October 5th.** Jim, Wendy, and Tuana will consolidate and distribute responses in advance of October 15th MB meeting. **ACTION:** Jim Edward, Wendy O'Sullivan and Tuana Phillips will draft a request for individuals to join a DEIJ action team to include a senior staff lead and an additional staff person to support the team's efforts. A request for participants will be distributed by September 18. Names of individuals from each jurisdiction and agency will be submitted by **noon Friday, September 25th.**

    - **DECISION:** CBP will begin addressing Citizens Advisory Committee recommendations related to public health issued July 21st, 2020.   - Restoration Economy
    - **ACTION:** Wendy O'Sullivan volunteered to review NPS models of tracking the number of federal, state and local jobs supported by funding to develop a system of tracking and estimating the number of jobs created by CBP funding.
    - **ACTION:** The Budget and Finance Working Group (BFWG) will discuss ways to track the impact of CBP funds on the broader economy including jobs directly supported by funds and local economies that benefit from CBP dollars. Chantal Madray will add this to October 2020 BFWG Agenda.
