- <u>Decision</u> Agreed to put strategies in "bins" (possibly fish, wildlife, people).
  - Will be presented during 2/12 MB meeting.
  - Request to consider developing a graphic to help visualize inter-connections in outcomes. In progress; draft prepared for meeting
  - Request to identify key linkages between outcomes and management strategies.

- Action Agreed to have an ad hoc workgroup work out options for a thematic release in March. (Committee includes: Mike Foreman, Kristin Wolf, Greg Barranco, Margaret Enloe, Charlie Stek, James Davis-Martin, Matt Fleming, Carin Bisland). The Communications Workgroup will also discuss options at their February 5 meeting and make a recommendation. In progress

- Action Communications office will work with the GITs to develop the executive summary for each strategy. GITs and Communications Workgroup recommend creating executive summaries for each "bin grouping" of strategies.
- Action Communications office will distribute a style guide to assist the drafters. In progress.
