

Management Board Meeting November 13, 2014 Actions and Decisions

MB Meetings Calendar

Action: CBP staff will distribute the 2015/2016 meetings calendar to members and staff with a
request to respond with any conflicts by November 28. We will ask for approval at the next MB
meeting. On agenda for January 15, 2015 meeting.

Management Strategy Development

- <u>Action</u>: CBP staff will email the new Bay Watershed Agreement poster to members. It will also be posted on the CBP website. <u>Completed</u>.
- Action: CBP will email the listing of all management strategy-related workgroup meetings to members. Completed.
- <u>Action</u>: A small team of CBP staff and coordinators will review the December 15 early drafts of management strategies for common challenges and consistency. Reviewers will also flag specific factors influencing and gaps for cross-GIT integration opportunities. <u>Completed.</u>
- Action: CBP staff will create a stakeholder database to help GITs and workgroups manage and communicate with their stakeholders. In progress.
- Action: The December Management Board meeting will include a discussion about the interim CBP Governance document; specifically, GIT membership criteria and the idea of GIT executive committees will be discussed. Postponed
- <u>Action</u>: CBP staff will poll Management Board members to determine availability for a two-day retreat in January (will consider January 15-16 and other dates). <u>Completed</u>.
- <u>Action</u>: CBP staff will distribute information about the contract for services to support management strategy development. <u>Completed</u>.
- Action: Sally Claggett will provide the link to the state task force reports for the Forest Buffer Initiative to Management Board staff for inclusion in the meeting notes. Completed.

Mid-Point Assessment

<u>Decision</u>: Recommended the Water Quality Goal Team's proposed leads for the Mid-Point Assessment priority decision points and the more detailed Mid-Point Assessment schedule to the PSC for final approval at their next meeting.

New Technologies for Landscape Conservation

• <u>Action</u>: Chesapeake Conservancy will provide a state-by -state cost estimate of their proposed land management tool to CBP for further consideration. <u>Completed</u>.

Basin-wide BMP Verification Framework

- <u>Decision</u>: The Management Board approved proceeding with the year-1 implementation of the Basin-wide BMP Verification Framework as outlined within the plan.
