RECOMMENDED PARTNERSHIP ACTIONS

- Refine and prioritize climate science needs and develop a resource plan.
- A Climate Directive pilot project.
- Advance conservation finance priorities.
- Improve coordination on national funding for climate.
- Establish a learning and capacity building network.



RECOMMENDED PARTNERSHIP ACTIONS

- Next steps for implementing the PSC Monitoring Report recommendations (related to climate monitoring).
- Create a Bay-wide plan for tidal wetland restoration, marsh migration, and coastal resiliency.
- Complete climate change-related activities crosswalk and promote consistent reporting.
- Improve understanding of Best Management Practice (BMP) responses to climate change conditions.
