> CBP Funding for GITs and Management Strategies (1:30-1:50pm)

- o Approximately \$840,000 is available to divide among <u>all</u> CBP GITs this year to fund projects supporting the management strategies. That is about 2-3 projects per GIT.
 - 2014 GIT funding supported three fisheries projects:
 - blue crab summer survey/brood data analyses, striped bass health indicator and forage species reference points. Total funding received for fish projects was ~\$170,000.
- Ex Comm members will discuss 2015 project priorities to support the four fisheries management strategies: blue crab, oyster restoration, forage fish and fish habitat.

 - Which management strategies or specific projects would benefit most from this partnership funding?
