Jeremy Carton completed his senior thesis at St. Mary's College on an assessment of sampling techniques that would be suitable for citizen scientists to collect benthic macroinvertebrates. The work was coordinated and guided by CRC staffer Kara Skipper supporting the Fish Forage outcome of the Bay Agreement by piloting a study on obtaining fish forage data in the undersampled shallow water habitats of Chesapeake Bay and its tidal tributaries.
