RESTORATIVE JUSTICE

Restorative justice is a theory of justice that emphasizes repairing the harm caused by criminal behavior.

It is best accomplished through cooperative processes that include all stakeholders. This can lead to transformation of people, relationships and communities

PRE-TRIAL WORK CREW: KEEPING COMMUNITIES AND THE ENVIRONMENT CLEAN AND GREEN

- Individuals performing the job tasks are on the Pre-Trial Services Diversion Work Crew and are supervised by Correctional Staff
- Our Diversion Program participants are either assigned to: ACS (Alternative Community Services) or IPSA (Intervention Program for Substance Abusers)
- Most diversion participants are first time offenders charged with misdemeanor offenses which include such charges as: simple assault, theft, alcohol related citations and possession of controlled dangerous substances
- Most cases are eligible for expungement, upon successful completion of either program, ACS or IPSA



SUCCESSFUL PAINTING AND CODING FOR ELECTRIC CAR CHARGING STATIONS














COUNTY FACILITIES

KEEP THE ENVIRONMENT CLEAN


- Tons of trash end up along shorelines and floating in the region's waterways
- Plastic bags, cigarette butts, Styrofoam and other types of trash threaten to further harm wildlife, increase pollution and choke streams and rivers
- Clogged storm drains cause flooding and other environmental and safety hazards

- This particular site became overrun with brush and trash. The drain became clogged due to brush growing into the drain and trash build-up
- This caused flooding, environmental and staff hazards

Our community service work force: removed trash, brush and landscaped. Successful in creating a smooth and uninhibited water run-off



FY16 – FY18 COMBINED WORK CREW STATS

- 24,594 combined number of bags of trash and debris removed
- 844 trips to county landfill
- 1,601 work crews used
- 10,028 work crew clients
- 60,168 work crew man hours
