- Submit number of samples collected per station in 2012 to L. Rubin for submission in NTN stations Table (Monitoring organizations)
- Training for Lab and Field techniques at USGS office Dover, Delaware and inform NTWG for interested parties (MEL)
- **NTWG Discussion item:** Work with NTWG to get consensus on what the protocols are for continuous monitoring stations (USGS, MD, ICPRB have their own protocols)

- Put together clear documentation on how to communicate Indicators correctly for NS (New NTWG coordinator)
