SRS Finance Strategy Work Session

DRAFT Project Scope

As of May 16, 2017

<u>Finance Strategy Working Session purpose</u>: Convene a one-day (9 AM to 3 PM) work session focused on the 2017 outcomes SRS agenda which will **result** in take away top line financial strategies that are specific/unique for Management Strategies and Action Items for each outcome by the day's end.

<u>Finance Strategy Working Session output</u>: Each participating GIT and Workgroup will develop and return to their GITS and workgroups with top line and specific/unique financial strategies for Management Strategies and Action Items for each outcome.

<u>Planning group</u>: Small planning group (group intended to sunset) convened to further develop and implement this scope; includes development and distribution of advance homework materials, securing space, speakers, and other logistics. Small group will work through a modified strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats (SWOT) analysis; identify overarching and common finance themes; and identify experts.

Members to include: Dan Nees, Jim Edward, Julie Winters, Emily Freeman, Carin Bisland, Kristin Saunders, Dave Goshorn, and volunteers from Budget and Finance Workgroup.

<u>Target audience</u>: For the 2017 outcomes SRS agenda, with February and May 2018 outcomes included:

- GIT Chairs (all GITs)
- GIT Coordinators
- Workgroup Chairs for 2017 outcome SRS agenda
- Staffers
- Outcome Leads (if different than those indicated above)

Vision for work session – plenary and breakout working sessions:

- Plenary session: Peer-to-peer facilitated panels of Partners and their new finance related contacts/partners who brought new resources to outcome implementation, and who together had early success in developing a new finance strategy for their outcome. Target is to work through two to three experiences. These are our peers, and they are early adopters.
 - Experience possibility #1: Protected Lands.
 - Experience possibility #2: Brook Trout.
 - Experience possibility #3: To be determined.
- Panels to include:
 - Facilitator.
 - GIT or Coordinator or Workgroup Chair peer.
 - Expert.
- Panel to cover:
 - Cite or state the Strategy/outcome/action.
 - What were the anticipated sources of funding/resources (monetary or non-monetary)/financing outside the CBPO that you determined would support this work? In other words, who else cared and how did you identify them? (question 1)

- How did those sources of financing work in concert with other financing mechanisms or funding sources? (question 2)
- What were the specific metrics used to determine project and/or funding success? Are those metrics currently incorporated into the current Management Strategy/Outcome/Workplan Action Item? (question 3)

Management Strategy/Outcome/Workplan Action Item Breakout Work Sessions:

- Each breakout will result development and take away of top line and specific/unique financial strategies for each Management Strategy/Outcomes/ Workplan Action Items.
- Four to six facilitated breakouts orchestrated into groups to be determined by the planning group.
- Each breakout will include an expert(s) to assist in content development.
- Each breakout will have advanced preparatory homework TBD.
- Each breakout will have a planning tool that includes: current management strategy/outcome/workplan action item matrix with work space to fill in the answers to:
 - 1. What are the anticipated sources of funding/resources (monetary or non-monetary)/financing opportunities outside the CBPO that you anticipate would support this work? In other words, who else cares?
 - 2. How would those sources of financing work in concert with other financing mechanisms or funding sources?
 - 3. What are the specific metrics used to determine project and/or funding success? Are those metrics currently incorporated into the current Management Strategy/Outcome/Workplan Action Item and/or format?
 - 4. Each breakout will delineate Management Strategy/Outcome/Workplan Action Items by priority for finance and develop a short list of caveats and necessary criteria required for delivering on questions 1, 2 and 3.
