The Scientific and Technical Advisory Committee (STAC) provides scientific and technical guidance to the Chesapeake Bay Program (CBP) on measures to restore and protect the Chesapeake Bay. To provide this guidance, STAC hosts workshops and reviews to produce a report that includes specific recommendations for the CBP and partners. With STAC's important role in science advising for the partnership, the Management Board requested the GIT Science Needs list be shared with STAC leadership which suggested incorporating workshop and review recommendations with the Science Needs List to show similarities and identify science gaps (unaddressed STAC recommendations).

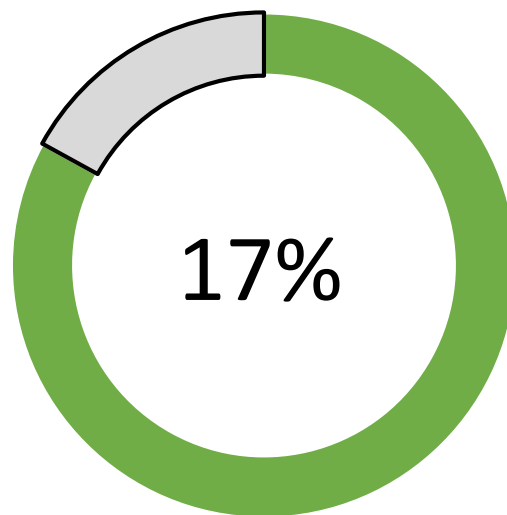


Status of Science Recommendations
